COMPETITION DETAILS:

- Swimming** **8 lane -25 meter short course FINA regulation lap pool**
Distances: Youth E – 50 m, Youth D/C – 100 m, Youth B/A/Jr/Sr – 200 m, Masters as per UIPM rules for age group.
- Fencing** **Round robin followed by ladder. Ladder count toward final point total as per UIPM rules.**
1 victory = 1 point.
- Combined Event** **Laser shooting, Grass Cross Country Type course.**
*Youth E – 1 x 400 m, Youth D – 2 x 400 m, Youth C – 2 x 800 m
Youth B – 3 x 800 m, Youth A/Jr/Sr – 4 x 800 m,
Masters – as Per UIPM rules for age group.
Youth E,D may shoot with 2 hands*
- Equestrian** **Jr, Sr, Masters – 1 m course**
*Youth Levels are permitted to ride subject to horse availability & entries submitted by closing date.
A lower level 0.75 m course will be provided, if applicable.
Points will not count toward final score for youth divisions as per UIPM rules.*

**Rules: The competition will be carried out according to the 2014/2015 UIPM rules.

Registration deadline for entries & payment is July 28 after which a \$50 late fee applies.

Fees:

The cost for a non-riding competitor is \$200 and for a riding competitor is \$250.
Fees include event accreditation, Saturday awards banquet and lunch Saturday and Sunday.
Individual registration includes relay participation Sunday.

The cost for a support is \$100 (adult) or \$80 (youth) and includes event accreditation, Saturday awards banquet and lunch Saturday and Sunday. The fee for the awards banquet only is \$50 (adult) or \$30 (youth). A youth is anyone under the age of 12.

International Competitors

Visas and Vaccinations: Some nations require a visa to enter Canada. Visiting nations should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into Canada prior to travelling to the event – learn more at immigration.gc.ca/visit. Pentathlon Canada cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if required

Insurance: Pentathlon Canada will not accept any responsibility, financial, or otherwise for loss, injury or illness of any Delegation member. All members of the attending Delegations must insure themselves with sufficient health, accident and liability insurance. By submitting the competition entry, your National Federation confirms that all persons named on the entry are covered by such insurance. All athletes must sign waivers and any athlete from outside of Canada must provide proof of medical insurance. International participants are responsible for personal insurance during their stay.

Firearms: Laser weapons/air pistols with low velocity are not considered firearms under Canadian law. It is recommended you travel with appropriate documentation for your pistol (including muzzle velocity specifications) and laser attachments (including laser type and safety specifications). If not required otherwise during your trip you can leave any pellet barrels at home.
