Rules

The competition will be run in accordance with the UIPM rules as of January 2018.

- Swimming – 25m indoor pool, 6 lanes
- Fencing – Indoor pistes
- Equestrian – Outdoor arena
- Laser-Run – Laser targets and cross country 800m running loop

All events will be contested with laser pistols. Pentathlon Ontario encourages participants to borrow or acquire a laser pistol prior to the event as only a limited number of pistols will be available at the event. All age divisions will contest the Laser-Run event, with distances varying as specified in the rules.

Junior, Senior, and Masters athletes will complete the equestrian event over a maximum 1 meter course and 0.9 m for Masters. Pentathlon Canada cannot guarantee a sufficient number of horses will be available for all competitors wishing to ride. Should a shortage of horses arise priority to riding will be given to Senior, Junior, and Masters competitors in that order. A lower level course of 0.75 m may be provided if applicable.

Visas and Vaccinations

Athletes from outside of Canada may require a visa to visit Canada. International athletes should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry to Canada prior to planning travel to the event. Firearms

Laser weapons and air pistols with low velocity are not considered firearms under Canadian law. It is recommended that athletes travel with appropriate documentation for their pistols (including muzzle velocity specifications) and laser attachments (including laser type and safety specifications). If not required at another time during your trip, Pentathlon Ontario recommends that pellet barrels be left at home.
